The Pastors Message:

The plain and simple truth about salvation.

"But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God." 1 Peter 1:19 - 21

In the world throughout Christianity you will find a very broad and never-ending thought on salvation and what one must do to be saved. However, with all that thought process and with all the differing opinions on the subject, only one thought counts, and that is what God said, "And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house." Acts 16:30 - 23 This is the one single time the question is directly asked and answered in the bible. The bible without question says that salvation is not "of works" "Not of works, lest any man should boast." Ephesians 2:9 and over and over the bible repeats that salvation is not of works. See Romans 3:20, 9:16, 11:16, 1Cor. 1:29-31, 2Tim. 1:9, Titus 3:3-5 and many more that destroy any thought of works for salvation. Lost people will believe anything that Satan put into their hearts, even works for salvation. This battle was fought thousands of years before I was born and if time goes on it will go on for thousands of years after I'm gone. "For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth." Romans 10:2 - 4 Anyone who believes that salvation includes "works of any sort" are "...being ignorant of God's righteousness..." and they will die lost and awake in hell. Now, let's look at why our works are not part of salvation, mankind is totally deprayed. You never find anywhere in the bible about God speaking highly of peoples work outside of

Christ. God in His word only continues to condemn man's works and tells mankind how sinful we truly are. People outside of Christ has no good, and people that are saved only do good "in Christ". "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death." Rom. 8:1 - 2 "But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:" 1Cor. 1:30 There is a reason for this fact, that salvation is only possible in Jesus Christ and not in anything else. It is His death, burial, and His resurrection, but it is also because of His blood, because it is His blood that cleanses all our sins. God said His blood cleanses us as white as snow, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9 also "Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works." Titus 2:14 When one is saved it is because of the very acts of Jesus Christ on the cross, it was He who died our death, paid our sin debt to God, and rose again from the grave for our resurrection. There is no place in this for our works, because our works would diminish what works He accomplished on the cross at Calvary. "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God". Hebrews 12:2 The shame and condemnation of the cross was for our sins He took with Him, if you are saved then Jesus took your sins to His cross. It is us who must believe this record of God, it is not of them who are working, but those who believe God's record of salvation. If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son. He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life." 1 John 5:9 - 12 Who do you believe, God or man? This is the plain and simple truth about salvation, Jesus Christ caves sinned, do you believe?

The sacrifice of Himself!
